## **Memorandum of Understanding – MadiSUN Backyard Solar Grant**

This Memorandum of Understanding is designed to establish a mutual understanding and detail the terms of participation for (Grantee) to participate in and receive grant funds from the MadiSUN Backyard Solar Grant administered by RENEW Wisconsin.
<b>RENEW Wisconsin</b> is a 501c3 not-for-profit organization located at 214 N. Hamilton Street (Suite 300), Madison, WI whose mission is to lead and accelerate the transformation to Wisconsin's renewable energy future through advocacy, education, and collaboration. The MadiSUN Backyard Program fosters the expansion of solar power among mission-based nonprofits and affordable housing providers in the City of Madison, issuing grants and providing support for organizations to install solar arrays on their facilities.
(Grantee) is a nonprofit community organization located at  (Grantee) mission is to provide primary medical, behavioral health, dental, and pharmacy services in five clinic locations in Dane and surrounding counties.
As part of receiving this MadiSUN Backyard grant, <b>RENEW Wisconsin</b> and ( <b>Grantee</b> ) will work together to publicly highlight the installation of the solar array to spread the word and educate Wisconsin residents about the benefits of solar.
Commitment by RENEW Wisconsin As part of this initiative, RENEW Wisconsin will
1. Reserve a grant of \$XXX until <u>December 31, 2024</u> .
2. Provide support and guidance to the grantee throughout the fundraising and installation process.
3. Make a good faith effort to attend and help publicize any solar education sessions, dedication ceremonies or other related events hosted by Grantee.

As part of its Financial Commitment  1. Provide all time and resources needed to install a <b>YY-kilowatt</b> solar array at its facility including collaborating with and overseeing contractors, providing materials and documentation and any other needed administration.
2. Raise all additional funds needed to complete the installation of the solar project within 12 months. Recognizing that this is a cost-sharing arrangement, Grantee will seek funding from additional sources including (its operating budget, Focus on Energy, a community fundraising campaign; please include all planned funding sources). If grantee does not install the solar array within 12 months, they understand that RENEW Wisconsin will inform the City of Madison and request an extension, subject to budget allocations, unless another mutually agreed solution is reached.
3. Check in with RENEW Wisconsin within 6 months from the date of this MOU, or no later than <b>May</b>

1, 2024 and provide a brief, written progress report on its fundraising and installation plan.

As part of its Outreach Commitment...

- 4. Share its solar story and educate its community about solar power through at least one of the following strategies:
  - A. Document its solar installation with photos and videos of key milestones of system installation and commissioning and make all photos or videos available to RENEW Wisconsin to share in promotional materials.
  - B. Prepare a case study or other guiding document that can be shared publicly and with RENEW Wisconsin.
- 5. Make information about the size and performance of the solar array, as well as expected cost savings and return-on-investment information, available to share in promotional materials and with RENEW Wisconsin.
- 6. Host an open house or dedication ceremony following the system's installation and commissioning and promote the event among its supporters, leaders and other key community members and members of the press *AND/OR* Host a solar information session, with support from RENEW Wisconsin, for other members of the community to learn about solar for their properties.

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- 7. By signing this MOU, \_\_\_\_\_ (**Grantee**) certifies that it is eligible to participate in this program as an organization in good financial standing to make this investment and with authority to make this decision.
- 8. This MOU does not constitute a contract detailing service delivery and terms to be signed between the Grantee and its solar contractor. Any contract(s) signed between the Grantee and its chosen installation contractor(s) will be exclusively between the two parties; RENEW Wisconsin is not responsible for those contract(s) and will not be a party to those contract(s).
- 9. No rights, responsibilities or liabilities will be assigned to RENEW Wisconsin through this program or grantee's pursuit of a solar array. Grantee will release and hold harmless RENEW Wisconsin and its affiliates, officers, agents and employees from any claims, damages, expenses and obligations arising from this program or any circumstances related to its facility or its pursuit of a solar array.
